MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
MAY 19, 2009

The regular meeting of the Mackinaw Township Board was called to order at 7:30 P.M. on May 19, 2009 at 10595 Wallick Road, Mackinaw City, Michigan. Supervisor Dean led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Also Present: Attorney Tim MacArthur, Assessor Eric Jacobson

Approval of Agenda as presented. Minutes of April 28, 2009 meeting approved as presented.

Attorney MacArthur gave a complete review of current tax cases. An appraisal has been received from the law firm representing the Courtyards. This will be reviewed by the Assessor and the Attorney for recommendations of further action.

The attorney for the township did file with the Supreme Court concerning the Superior Hotel Case. It will be several months before anything is decided on this.

Keck reported on the recent school election. There were 202 votes cast which was approximately 20% of eligible voters. This was one of the highest percentages in Cheboygan County.

After a brief discussion concerning roads in the Township, a motion by Bertchinger, second by Rogala to request a quote for cost to pave the portion of Hebron Mail Route that was improved last year. This quote should state the exact dimensions to be paved. All aye, motion approved.

Jacobson discussed the 14-Point Review received from the State. He said he had completed this document and it was ready for supervisor signature and return to the State. It was agreed that a policy should be in place to deal with public requests for property information. Keck stated he would put this item on future agenda.

Mackinaw Band Booster Calendar order is due. There will be six calendars ordered for the upcoming year.

Treasurer's report accepted as presented. Warrant list for May was reviewed. All bills will be paid and a letter written to the Village concerning the fire board. Motion by Keck, second by Rogala to pay May bills.

Motion by Rogala, second by Bertchinger to appoint Nancy Campbell to represent the Township on the Library Board. All aye, motion carried.

Bertchinger & Rogala requested copies of appraisal for Courtyards.
