Jeff Hingston, President of Mackinaw City, spoke to the Board concerning a grant they are seeking to purchase property along the Straits. This property is the home belonging to Jane McLott, who passed away recently. If purchased, this property would be combined with the park next door, known as the Gary Williams Park. This grant, if approved would provide 75% of the funds for purchase. The Village would be responsible for raising the balance. This park would be handicap accessible and provide a stopping off place for canoes and kayaks along the Blue Water Trail. Mr. Hingston is currently seeking letters of support to be submitted with this grant. It was also noted that this park is in Mackinaw Township and could possibly qualify for some support from the Township. Supervisor Dean thanked Mr. Hingston and reported this would be an item on the May Board Agenda.

MacArthur suggested a Board Resolution would be advisable in supporting this project.

Attorney MacArthur reported to the Board on the current meeting held concerning Flood Plain maps. He said decisions will have to be made in the future concerning this as it will have an effect on anyone wanting to construct in the Township. Mortgages will not be available unless Flood Insurance is purchased to cover any land in the Flood Plain.

Information concerning current tax issues were covered in information sent to the Clerk. These will be shared with the members at the May meeting.
